Working closely with local partners, ZOV has touched the lives of over 400 children since being established in 2006.


In 2015 ZOV got a special recognition as one of the best services for children from specialists in Social care area in North Bulgaria

We want to support 200 children by 2016, only £10 per month or £120 a year provides a child with a trip away, weekly music, art dance and sports sessions, a student mentor and weekly educational help, Christmas party and present. Children with disabilities and special needs will be provided with specialist music, speech, art therapy. It can make a huge difference to a child's future.



HELPING BULGARIAN CHILDREN IN CARE

Vision: ZOV believes that all children deserve the chance for a bright future and that every child needs to be loved and supported.

ZOV supports children who have grown up in institutional care and often suffered severe trauma, by helping them prepare for life outside the home until they are secure and independent. We see each child's unique potential and facilitate the development of their skills and talents, to help them build their confidence, by providing a range of different creative and educational programmes. Our dedicated team of staff have built lasting relationships with many children since ZOV started in 2006. Now many of these children are supporters, volunteers and employees of ZOV today.

2015 has been an amazing year with 144 children benefitting from the programmes that **ZOV** ran



Educational & Employment successes 6 youths completed paid work experience with 5 gaining full or part time employment. 6 children won a Stipendii Grant which is an education grant competition that ZOV helps administer.

70 children, as part of the educational club, received one to one mentoring support. As a result of this many children's school results and general motivation have increased.

56 children participated in a range of weekly sessions including music, dance, English, sports, computers and cooking.

7 environmental and educational trips.

2 staff training sessions organised by ZOV on child behavioural issues and problem solving.

Volunteering

45 student volunteers from the

local university provided weekly educational and mentoring

support. With two previous

mentors now employed by ZOV.

Building Life Skills

30 Children participated in the Football life skills project, which student mentors implemented utilising the manual produced by ZOV, to improve key life skills.

20 children received medals from participating in local and national sports tournaments

10 children from the Gabrovski family centre have developed life skills, such as budgeting, growing vegetables, tending gardens, cooking, etc.; increasing their confidence levels and independence.

Providing Recreational Opportunities

42 children participated in a Christmas Bazaar raising money through selling gifts they had made. 12 children from the Gorna family centre for children with severe needs organised their first trip away from a home.

Child Empowerment

52 children with a range of disabilities received weekly music, art and speech therapy support. 2 children no longer need the use of a wheelchair. ZOV participated in 5 folklore festivals. The only amateur folklore group in Bulgaria comes from the Penyo and Maria orphanage
